

INFORMATION ON THE TREATMENT OF PERSONAL DATA

art. 13 of the EU Regulation n. 679/2016

This page describes how to manage the site in relation to the processing of users' personal data while consulting it. The information is also based on Recommendation n. 2/2001 that the European authorities for the protection of personal data, reunited in the Group established by art. 29 of the directive n. 95/46 / EC, adopted May 17, 2001 to identify some minimum requirements for the collection of personal data online, and, in particular, the methods, timing and nature of the information that data controllers must provide users when they connect to web pages, regardless of connection purposes.

THE "OWNER" OF THE TREATMENT

Following to the consultation of this site, data relating to identified or identifiable persons may be processed.

PLACE OF DATA PROCESSING

The processing operations connected to the web services of this site take place at the aforementioned Ravenna site and are only handled by employees or collaborators, authorized to the treatment.

No data deriving from the web service is communicated or disseminated. However, Internet providers receive data from navigation of users as they are necessary for the performance of their activities, while companies that provide assistance services and maintenance on IT systems can come into contact with user data in case of maintenance intervention on systems.

The personal data provided by users who request dispatch of informative material are used only to perform the service itself or the service requested and are not communicated to third parties, unless the communication is imposed from legal obligations or is strictly necessary for the fulfilment of the user's requests.

TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED

Navigation data

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation course, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This information is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but by their very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of computers used by users who connect to the site, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used in submitting the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numeric code indicating the status of the response given by the server (success, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the computer environment of the user.

This data is used only to obtain anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to control the correct functioning and are cancelled immediately after processing. The data could be used for the ascertainment of responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the site: except for this eventuality, at the state Web contact data does not persist for more than seven days.

DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY THE USER

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of emails to the addresses indicated on this site involves the following acquisition of the sender's address, necessary to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data included in the message.

Specific summary information will be progressively reported or displayed on the website pages set up for special services on request.

OPTIONAL NATURE OF DATA PROVISION

Apart from what specified for navigation data, the user is free to provide personal data contained in the request forms or indicated in contacts with the Office to solicit the sending of informative material or other communications.

Failure to provide personal data may make it impossible to obtain what is requested.

Before the release of the data, the reading of the information is proposed, with a request for consent to process the data released.

METHODS OF THE DATA PROCESSING

Personal data is processed by automated tools for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which have been collected. Specific security measures are observed to prevent the loss of data, illicit or incorrect use and non- authorized accesses.

RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY

In relation to the above-mentioned processing and the related data existing in our archives, can be exercised the rights according to Chapter III, Articles from 15 to 22 of EU Regulation 2016/679, specifically:

- Right of access (art.15);
- Right of rectification (art.16);
- Right to cancellation (so-called right to oblivion, art. 17);
- Right to limit the processing (art.18);
- Right to data portability (Article 20);
- Right of opposition (art.21).

RIGHT TO LODGE A COMPLAINT WITH A SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY

According to the art. 13, paragraph 2, lett. d) You are informed of the right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor Authority for the protection of Personal Data if you find a violation of your rights as a data subject or for matters relating to the processing of your personal data.
